- Mediate conflict between students and manage classroom behaviours through evidence-based developmentally appropriate techniques
- Ensure the classroom remains safe and conducive to learning at all times
- Develop positive relationships with families, students, and coworkers built on mutual trust and respect
- Communicating with parents and families of child's progress and needs throughout the day through the brightwheel app
- Track students' developmental progress through informal and formal assessment
- Works with Center Director to ensure classroom and administrative work is compliant with AZDHS rules and regulations
